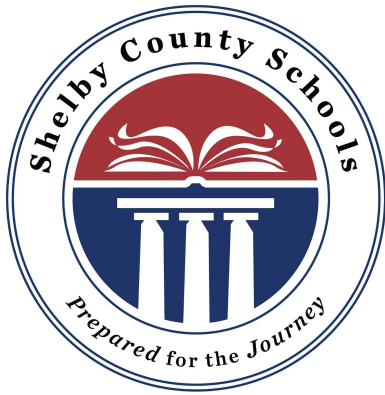


# Shelby County Schools Community Education



**Reopening Plan 2020-2021**

# Overview

The Shelby County School District recently released its Reopen Schools Plan, which details a three-phased school operating status when schools reopen. The reopening plan for the After School Care Program takes each of these phases into consideration:

## Back Together

Back Together welcomes students back for both traditional (in-person) or remote learning.

Recommendations will be implemented to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

## Cautious Together

Cautious Together will be implemented when the community spread of COVID-19 is at a higher risk outlined by the ADPH and the CDC.

Enhanced measures will be implemented to mitigate the spread.

## eLearning Together

eLearning for all students would be implemented when schools are closed temporarily based on guidance from the ADPH and or an order issued by the Governor.

***\*Presently, we do not know which phase of the plan SCS will start in. Parents should make contingency plans based on all three phases.***

# Back together

## ASCP Operations

- ASCP open Monday-Friday (**5 days a week**), beginning with the first day of school on August 13
- Students will be subdivided into smaller groups and will maintain social distance from other groups utilizing additional space
- Students and staff required to wear a face covering / mask, except for outdoor playtime and in the gym.
- Frequent cleaning and sanitizing of commonly touched surfaces
- Daily sanitization of school playgrounds and bathrooms
- Increased focus on hand sanitizers, hand-washing, and respiratory etiquette for students and staff
- There will be no daily drop-ins

## ASCP Operations

- Students who arrive at ASCP presenting with symptoms of illness (Fever of 100.4 or greater, cough, congestion not related to allergies or sinus issues, shortness of breath, vomiting, or diarrhea) will be isolated from other students
- Parents will be called and will be expected to check sick student out of ASCP as soon as possible
- Parents will not be allowed into the ASCP area for checkout
- Details on the new checkout procedure will be coming soon
- Due to space and staff concerns, some ASCP sites will be capped for enrollment once capacity has been reached
- A waiting list will be established at capped sites and students will be enrolled as space and staff permit
- There will be no Enrichment classes the first semester, unless the class can be taught virtually

# Cautious together

## ASCP Operations

- Students will only attend ASCP the **two days** they are assigned to attend school
- Monday/Tuesday - ASCP will open for one half of students assigned to report to school
- Wednesday - ASCP closed for cleaning. All students home for eLearning.
- Thursday/Friday - ASCP will open for other half of students assigned to attend school
- All procedures outlined in the Back Together section will still apply

## ASCP Operations

- Schools / ASCP will be closed temporarily based on guidance from the Alabama Department of Public Health and/or an order from the Governor
- Schools / ASCP will reopen when the state order is lifted
- School / ASCP closings could impact a single school or school zone based on community spread

# ASCP Fees

## Back Together

- **Non-refundable** registration fee of \$50
- \$190/month - full time
- \$130/month - free/reduced/employee
- \$195 PreK (full time) \$135 (F/R/E)
- Because we may have to shift from one phase of the plan to another, **the auto-payment draft option has been suspended** for the time being to avoid parents being overcharged
- **Parents will make payments through EZChildtrack using E-Check**
- The amount owed will depend on the current phase of operation

## Cautious Together

- **Non-refundable** registration fee of \$50
- \$100/month - full time
- \$70/month - free/reduced/employee
- \$105 PreK (full time) \$75 (F/R/E)
- Because we may have to shift from one phase of the plan to another, **the auto-payment draft option has been suspended** for the time being to avoid parents being overcharged
- **Parents will make payments through EZChildtrack using E-Check**
- The amount owed will depend on the current phase of operation

# ASCP Fees

## eLearning Together

- If ASCP is forced to close due to a specific school closure or district-wide closure, monetary credit will be applied for any unused days
- Monetary credit will be applied toward any days used once ASCP is able to reopen
- Refunds will not be issued unless a student withdraws for the remainder of the school year
